This area was created in the 40s by the grandfather of the current owner. The vineyard is located in part on gravelly soils and the other on clay-limestone slopes. A perfect harmony found in the wine due to the assembly of its two terroirs.

Winemaking

Winemaking: Traditional (21 days of maceration) can reveal all the fruity and tannic potential of the grapes picked at optimum ripeness.

Breeding year minimum in our cellars.

Tasting Notes

A nice roundness in mouth with mellow tannins. This wine is fruity, crispy and balanced. The final brings aromatic notes of blueberry.

Grape Variety

Merlot 80%, Cabernet Sauvignon 20%
